



Proposed Junee “Shared Community Resources” June 2022 Survey Results

In June 2022, Junee Community Network undertook a survey of the 100+ Not-for-Profit Community Groups and Sporting Clubs based, or operating, within Junee Shire⁽¹⁾ which asked: **“Which items/projects would your organisation potentially use at least once year, if it was available as Shared Community Resource?”**

The survey link was emailed directly to the local Not-for-Profits, along with other local organisations that conduct regular community focussed events, activities and festivals. The survey was also posted to the [Junee Community Events and Info Facebook page](#).

The survey then asked respondents to indicate their **First and Second Priority** (excluding the Portable EFTPOS Terminals⁽²⁾) and every proposed Shared Resource were listed as a First **AND** Second Priority, multiple times.

Marketing Resources and Event Enhancement Accessories were both most highly rated as a Priority. If we combined the two Marquee responses together, they were the third highest priority; with the remaining proposed Shared Resources gathering approximately 12% to 15% of the Priority responses each.

Finally the survey asked **If the proposed "Junee Community Storage Facility" was constructed, would your organisation have equipment that it would like to store there, and would make that equipment available to other local community groups?**

82% of respondents indicated that they would use the Shared Community Resources, IF the equipment were available.

6% of respondents stated they have equipment that they would to store within the proposed Junee Community Storage Facility **AND** they would make that equipment available for other local not-for-profit organisations to utilise.

4% of respondents advised that they have already have equipment that they would be prepared to make available to other local not-for-profit organisations to utilise but they did not need to store those resources in the proposed Junee Community Storage Facility.

Now that priorities for the various Shared Community Resources have been determined, Junee Community Network will work with the 100+ Not-for-Profit Community Groups and Sporting Clubs based, or operating, within Junee Shire⁽¹⁾ to seek funding for the different projects. Once funding has been obtained, we will promote the availability of each Shared Community Resource within the **Shared Resources**⁽⁴⁾ section of the **Junee Community Directory**⁽⁵⁾, enabling the local Junee community to quickly determine what shared resources are available and to quickly book the equipment.

- (2) Through previous data collection, Junee Community Network had already determined there was a significant demand, by local community organisations, for a number of Portable EFTPOS Terminals to be available for loan/hire. Most organisations only require EFTPOS facilities a few times a year... and there are about half a dozen local organisations that require MULTIPLE EFTPOS Terminals on a single day or weekend a year (eg Junee Show Society, and Illabo Show Society for their annual Shows and Junee Business and Trades for their annual Christmas on Broadway event). Grant applications for a set of six EFTPOS Terminals and related accessories have already been submitted to a couple of funding bodies.
